CHALLENGES



The international education industry is rapidly evolving, with new policies, technologies (AI, DeepSeek), and market shifts requiring deeper global collaboration. Institutions and partners faced the challenge of understanding these changes while building resilient, forward-looking strategies.

SOLUTIONS



- The four-day conference offered a multi-dimensional program:
- Knowledge Exchange: Forums on big data, low-age study trends, and global perspectives ("World Youth Talk").
- Debate & Dialogue: GEA speakers shared practices under the theme "Rooted Locally, Dialoguing Globally", exploring curriculum design, management, and innovation.
- Future-Focused Forums: Sessions covering DSE, AI-powered recruitment, emerging markets, and sustainability.
- Partner Collaboration: 120+ international institutions from UK, Australia, Malaysia, and Asia-Pacific showcased insights and created new pathways.
- Technology Launch: Announcement of GEAR, GEA's new partner management and Al-powered system to simplify workflows and enhance efficiency.
